



Annual Profile Update

Purpose

As a supplier to one or more of our business segments (Access, Defense, Fire & Emergency, and Commercial), we ask that your company annually update your Business Status Certification (BSC), self-certifying to your company's size status per the Small Business Administration's (SBA) table of small business size standards.

If supplying for Oshkosh Defense, in accordance with the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA) and FAR clause 52.204-10, Reporting Executive Compensation and First-Tier Subcontract Awards, Oshkosh is required to file a subaward report for our first-tier subcontractors. To be in compliance with this FAR clause, all Oshkosh Defense suppliers will also be required to complete the FFATA Certification.

Updating Business Status Certification (BSC)

Suppliers will use this Job Aid to perform the steps to comply with the annual BSC requirement.

1. Click the link in the email notification to access Oshkosh's Jaggaer Supplier Portal
 - a. This will bring you to the supplier log in screen; you will use your normal login information

**Log in can be executed by any means, however, there is a link to the portal included for your convenience on the notification from Jaggaer*

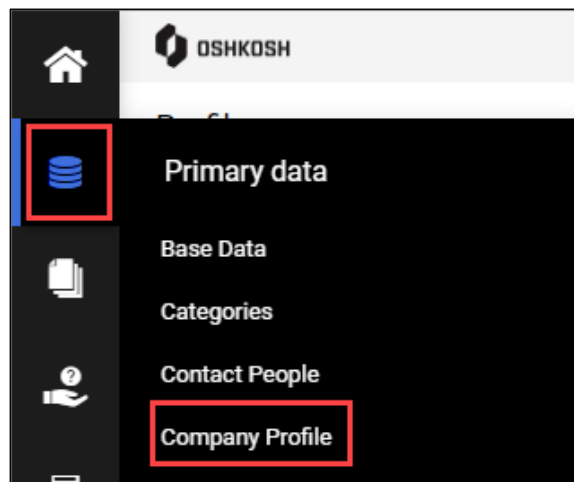

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7. Final requirement is at the bottom which is to sign and certify accuracy
a. All Sections are required

The offeror represents and certifies that the information provided is true and understands that Under 15 U.S.C., any person who misrepresents a firm's status as a business concern that is small, HUBZone small, small disadvantaged, service-disabled veteran-owned small, economically disadvantaged woman-owned small, or women-owned small eligible under the WOSB Program in order to obtain a contract to be awarded under the preference programs established pursuant to section 8, 9, or 15, 31, and 36 of the Small Business Act or any other provision of Federal law that specifically references section 8(d) for a definition of program eligibility, shall:

(i) Be punished by imposition of fine, imprisonment, or both;

(ii) Be subject to administrative remedies, including suspension and debarment; and

(iii) Be ineligible for participation in programs conducted under the authority of the Small Business Act.

Updating Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA)

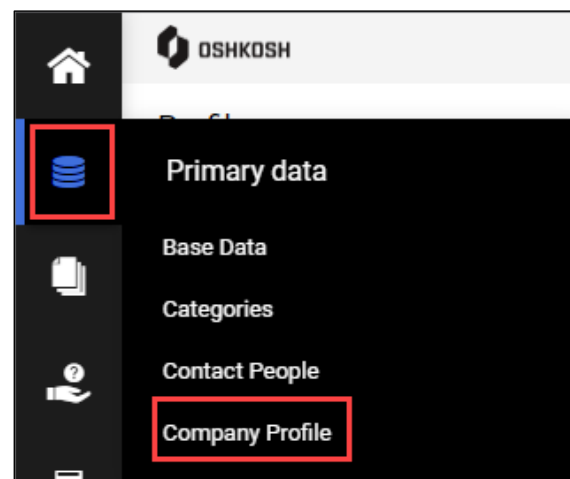
Suppliers that support or will be supporting Oshkosh Defense will use this Job Aid to perform the steps to comply with the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA) and FAR clause 52.204-10.

**This is only required for Oshkosh DEFENSE Suppliers. All other suppliers must only indicate they are not a supplier to Oshkosh Defense at the top of the FFATA certification.*

1. Log in to Oshkosh Jaggaer Supplier Portal or continue to the FFATA certification tab after completion of the BSC.

2. Once logged in, navigate to the second option (Primary Data) on the left side of the dashboard
3. When the window of options opens, select "Company Profile"





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4. Within the profile page, select the tab on the top "FFATA"

5. Section one will be to meet the FAR 52.204-10 requirement

- You must first select the drop down option for **"Are you or will you be a supplier to Oshkosh Defense?"** and select **"yes"** if you are a direct supplier to Oshkosh Defense, if not select **"no"**
- If answered **"yes,"** all sections (excluding Parent Vendor Name & Parent Unique Entity ID) are required
 - If answered **"no,"** no additional steps required
 - Note:** Zip code is 9-digit, no dash, space, or special characters
- There is a link to instructions on obtaining a Unique Entity ID from SAM.gov below that field
 - Note:** UEI is 12 alphanumeric characters

- The final question will only be required if you answered yes/yes/no. This will require the names, titles, and compensation of the highest compensated executives if not reported through SEC
